Currently, 25.7% of the 83,852 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 64.0%, renter occupied; and 10.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 82,778 housing units in the area - 27.1% owner occupied, 61.2% renter occupied, and 11.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.57%. Median home value in the area is \$398,509, compared to a median home value of \$177,257 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 7.99% annually to \$585,269.
