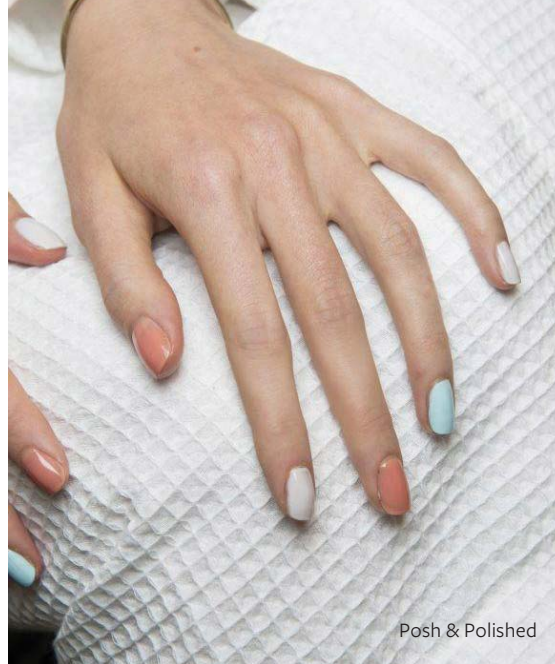

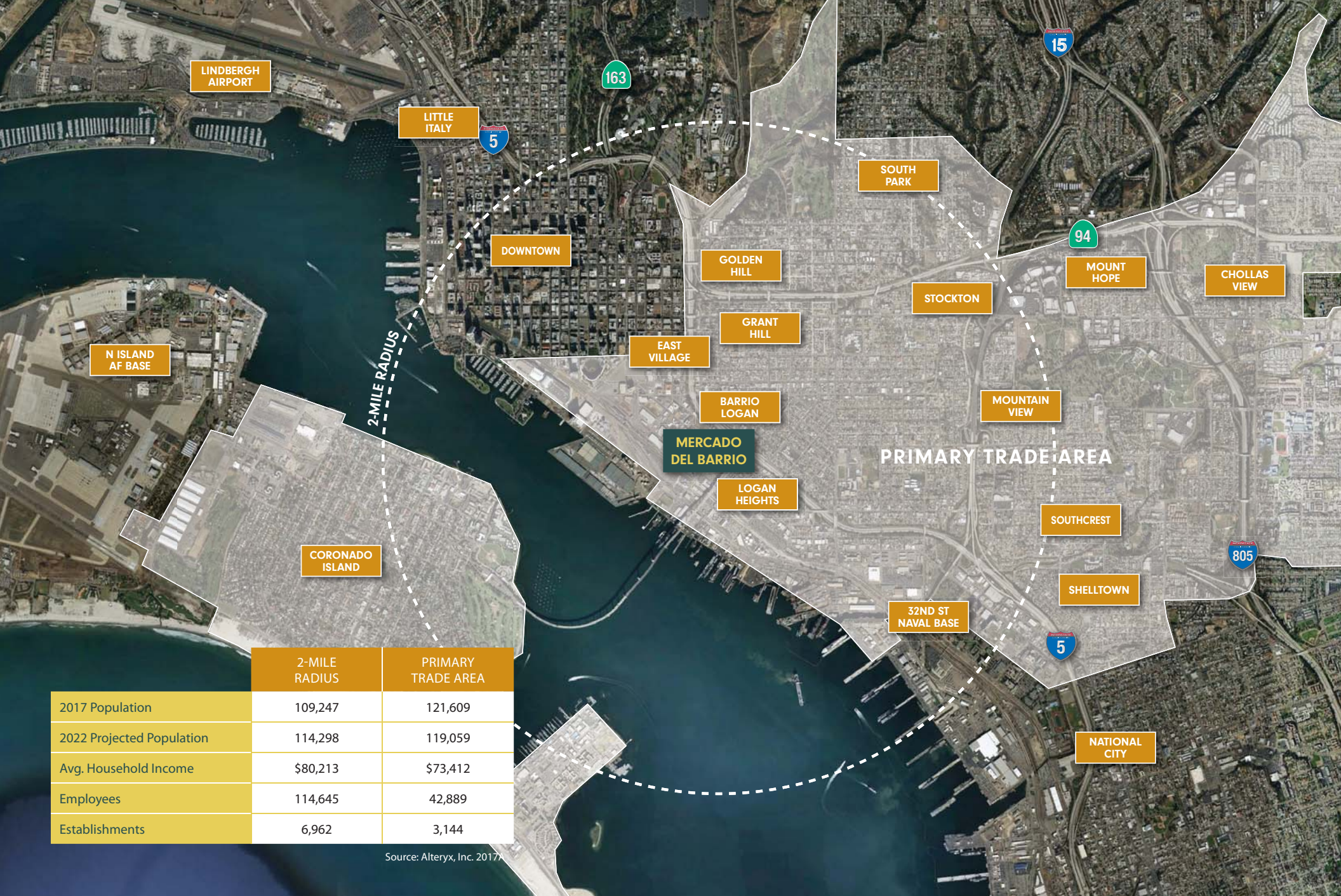

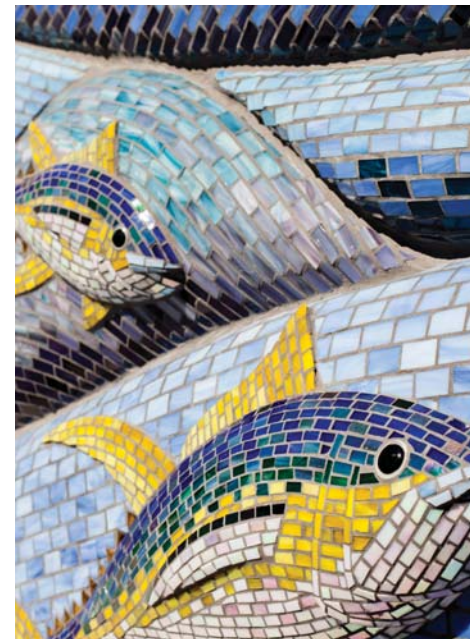
Shea Nabs 7 Leases at San Diego's Mercado del Barrio
