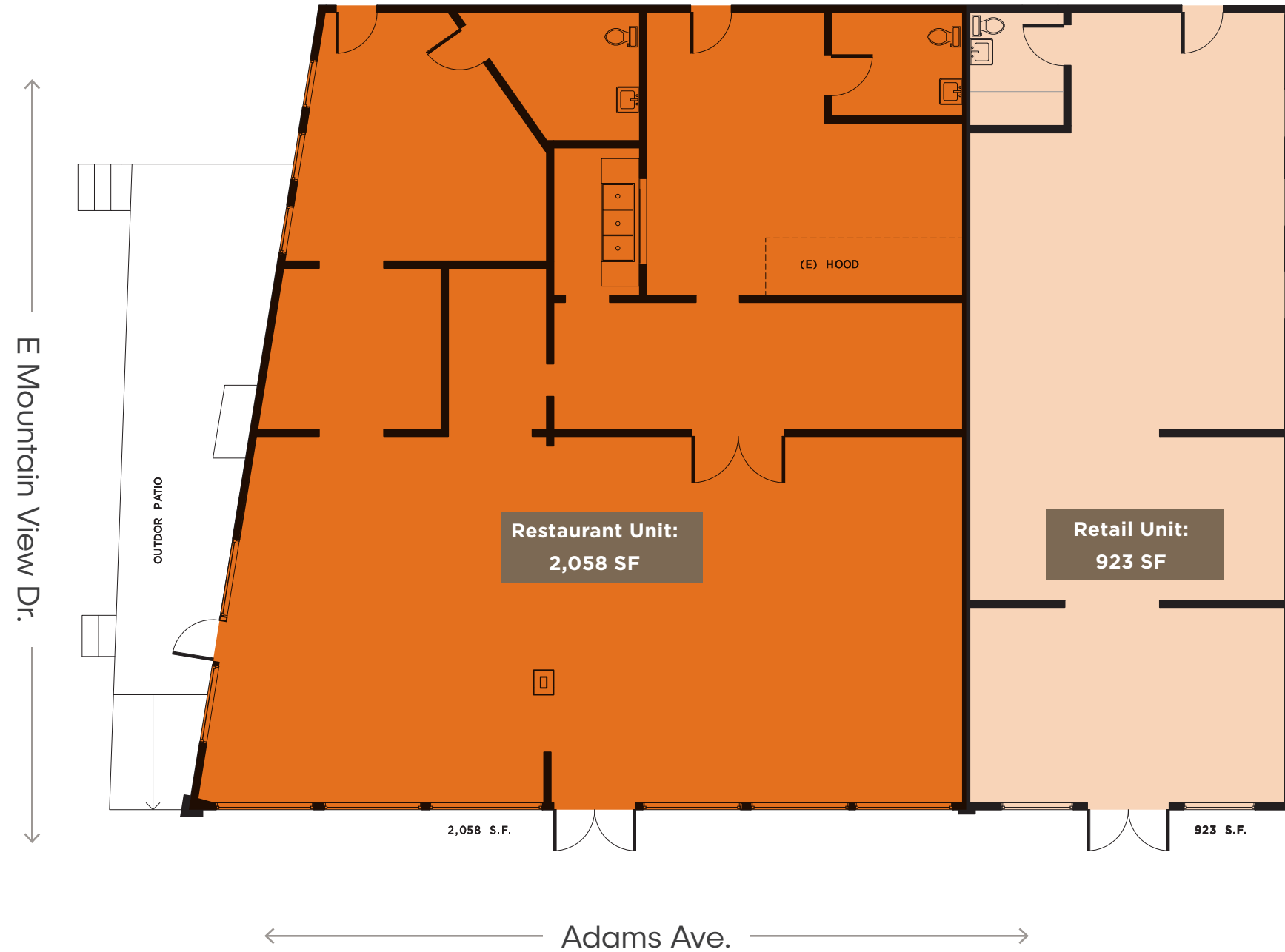

HISTORY OF NORMAL HEIGHTS

Normal Heights history dates back to the 1800s when it was only farmland. In 1907 trolley tracks were installed, bringing more population to the area, but the turning point for the business development of Normal Heights was a carpenter named Bertram Carteri, who began buying, fixing up and selling houses. He later built his first commercial building, which is now known as the Carteri Center.

HISTORY OF KENSINGTON

Kensington was originally planned and organized in 1910 by the Kensington Park Land Company. This unique neighborhood features stone gateways, ornamental lighting, and curving streets, giving it a small town and historic ambience.



ADAMS AVENUE UNPLUGGED

This unique event showcases local bands performing inside restaurants, bars, coffee shops, and galleries all down Adams Avenue, bringing music lovers and foodies together. This is the perfect opportunity for San Diego to experience the rich neighborhood culture of Adams Avenue.

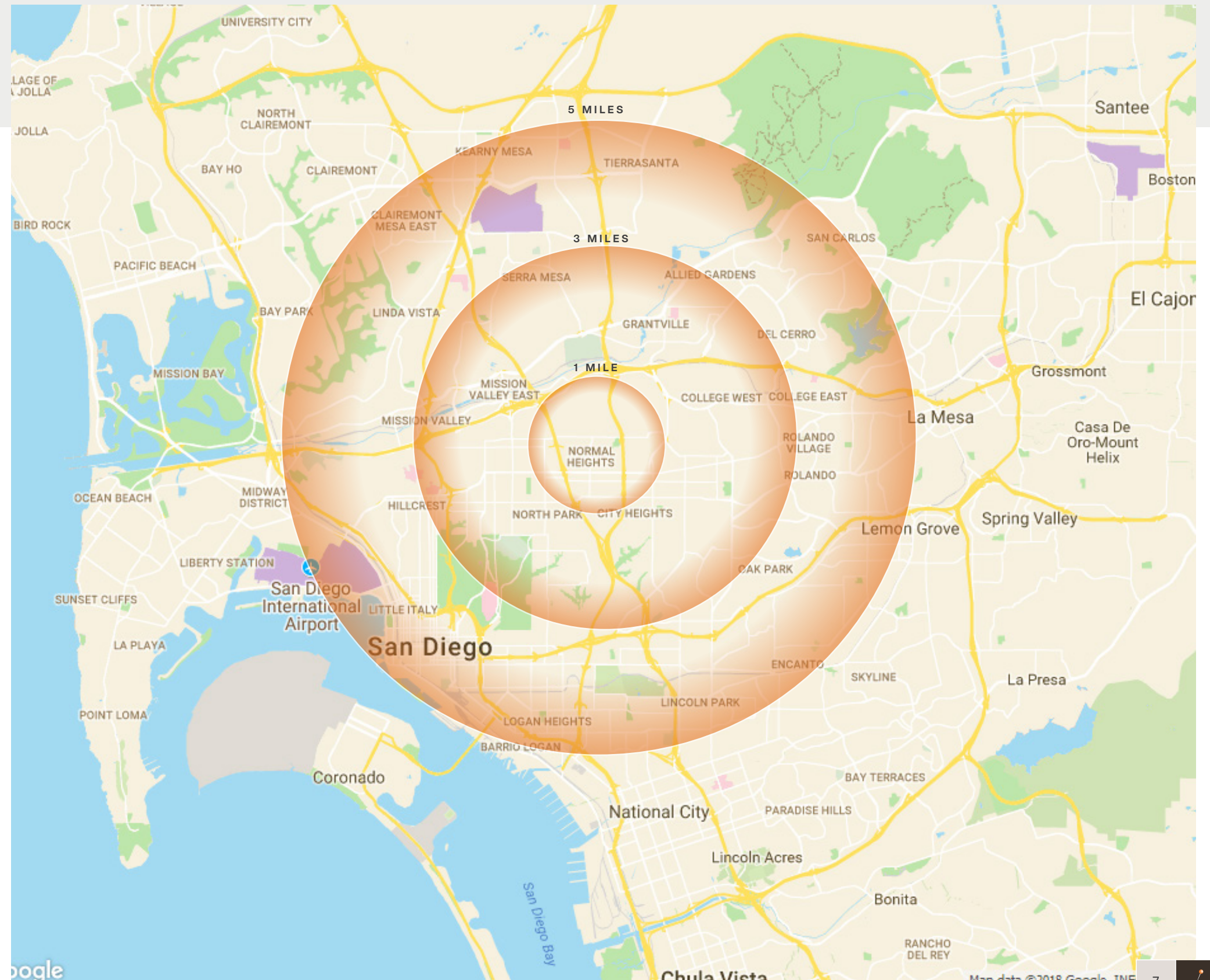
