





Floor Plan

HISTORY

Originally bringing visitors to University Heights were the new cable cars leading to the beloved Mission Cliff Park, an amusement park filled with rides, a shooting gallery, and vaudeville performances. However, the main catalyst for the community's spike in growth was the San Diego Electrical Railway, which made its way to Adams Ave. in 1907, as well as an abundant supply of water coming to San Diego around the same time, and stimulating a \$6 million increase in new construction.

Become part of the action at The Boulevard in North Park. The quick gentrification of the area add an extra advantage to this rare and unique restaurant opportunity.

























