





### What is Happening Around *Escondido*




A weekly farmers market brings together the local community every Tuesday at Heritage Garden Park.

With a variety of vendors, the Farmers Market offers visitors a well-crafted mix of sourced goods alternating from local farmers, artisans, and businesses in San Diego County. Attendees can find fresh produce, floral arrangements, delicious food, baked goods, crafts, and more every week.



Cruisin' Grand has spectators traveling back in time as they watch a parade of vintage cars. Every Friday night from June to September, Grand Avenue showcases an array of pre-1974 vehicles. Each week highlights a different model type, ranging from hot rods, antiques, to customs. Visitors can stroll downtown checking out the classics and visit local shops and restaurants that stay open late to accommodate the fun event.



2nd Saturday is a celebration of Art and Culture in Escondido. Through community driven magec (Museums & Arts: Growing Escondido Culture) local businesses and museums host unique events every month. These events differ from pop-ups, exhibit openings, art shows, murals at Esco Alley, and performances. 2nd Saturdays enhances community appreciation and support of its growing art scene.



Nothing brings the city together more than it's biannual festivals on Grand Avenue. For over 30 years the Escondido Street Festival has been held every Spring followed by the Grand Avenue Festival in the Fall. The festivals are centered around live music, delicious food, and family fun, complete with a Kids Zone, beer and wine garden, and talented artists showcasing their gifts at Art in the Garden at Heritage Park.
