
CRUISIN' GRAND

Cruisin' Grand has spectators traveling back in time as they watch a parade of vintage cars. Every Friday night from June to September, Grand Avenue showcases an array of pre-1974 vehicles. Each week highlights a different model type, ranging from hot rods, antiques, to customs. Visitors can stroll downtown checking out the classics and visit local shops and restaurants that stay open late to accommodate the fun event.

STREET FESTIVALS


Nothing brings the city together more than it's bi-annual festivals on Grand Avenue. For over 30 years the Escondido Street Festival has been held every Spring followed by the Grand Avenue Festival in the Fall. The festivals are centered around live music, delicious food, and family fun, complete with a Kids Zone, beer and wine garden, and talented artists showcasing their gifts at Art in the Garden at Heritage Park.

CALIFORNIA CENTER FOR THE ARTS

The California Center for the Arts, Escondido, is North San Diego County's cultural hub, featuring a concert hall, theater, and art museum. Hosting diverse events like Música en la Plaza and festivals, it serves as a venue for both artistic and personal gatherings. Guided by a dedicated Board of Trustees, the center enriches cultural experiences and arts education for the community and beyond.



SAN DIEGUITO RIVER PARK

Park is a vast 55-mile greenway from Del Mar to Volcan Mountain, offering over 65 miles of trails for hiking, biking, and equestrian activities. Managed by the San Dieguito River Valley Conservancy, the park covers 92,000 acres, featuring lush greenery, the San Dieguito Lagoon, and diverse recreational programs like full moon hikes and the Trails & Ales series, combining hiking with craft beer tasting.



SAN DIEGO ZOO SAFARI PARK

The San Diego Zoo Safari Park sprawls across 1800 acres in the picturesque San Pasqual Valley. Renowned for its diverse collection of nearly 3,000 animals representing 400 species, the park offers a unique safari experience. Visitors can explore expansive grassland exhibits via the Africa Tram, encountering free-range species like antelopes, giraffes, buffalo, cranes, and rhinoceros.



QUEEN CALIFIA'S MAGICAL CIRCLE

Queen Califia's Magical Circle, located in Kit Carson Park is a unique American sculpture garden and the final international project by French artist Niki de Saint Phalle. Inspired by California's cultural roots, it features nine large-scale sculptures, a captivating "snake wall," and a maze entryway adorned with mosaic tiles. The central courtyard showcases Queen Califia on a five-legged eagle, surrounded by totemic sculptures reflecting
