



Retail Space in the Heart of *Hillcrest*






Floor





Hillcrest is a vibrant uptown neighborhood in San Diego in close proximity to Downtown and Balboa Park. It is a popular destination for both locals and visitors that ranks high in daytime traffic and walk-ability. This centric neighborhood welcomes all with a diverse mix of restaurants. cafes, bars, boutique stores, and community driven events.











Since the Spring of 1997, Normal Street in Hillcrest has transitioned into San Diego's largest Farmers Markets every Sunday. With over 175 vendors it draws in an average of 10,000 visitors every weekend to shop from an array of local offerings. Vendors present organic produce, local seafood, fresh cut flowers, incredible craftsmanship, food trucks, and so much more. What makes this Farmers Market stand out is its variety and emphasis on international cuisine.

City Fest takes over 5th Avenue every August as the ultimate community art and music festival. Stretching over 9 city blocks and attaching 150,000 visitors it is a fun event for all in attendance. The blocks are lined with a plethora of local food vendors, games, craft cocktails, and a kids zone. It is an all day event with a full music lineup split between two stages and multiple interactive art exhibits throughout showcasing local businesses and talent.

Every month Hillcrest hosts two reoccurring events, Walk-in-Art and Hillcrest Classic Car Show. Every 1st Thursday, Mural Alley comes alive for Walk-in-Art. With live music, food vendors, and of course art, highlighting a new artist and signature cocktail at every event. The largest LGBTQ+ car club, Great Autos of Yesteryear, hosts Hillcrest's Saturday Car Show every 3rd weekend. At every show a few dozen car collectors share their classics and rare automobiles with other car enthusiasts.

While Pride month ends in June, Hillcrest continues the celebrate through July with it's annual Pride Parade and Block Party. This mile and a half long parade is among the largest Prides in the United States, attracting over 250,000 supporters. Participants create over 100 colorful floats to honor the event and designated theme of the year. After the parade and through the evening, Hillcrest is converted into a giant block party with live DJ's and entertainment.
