Old Town, dating back to 1769 as the "birthplace" of California, lies northwest of Downtown San Diego. This lively neighborhood blends Mexican heritage with historic charm, offering a variety of shops, diverse restaurants, and vibrant theaters. The Old Town San Diego State Historic Park preserves 19th-century adobe homes, a schoolhouse, and a graveyard, providing a glimpse into early colonial life. Notably, Kit Carson first raised the American flag here in 1846, and the area is also famous for sightings of ghosts.

Harney Street Market



Every Saturday and Sunday between San Diego Avenue and Congress Street, the Harney Street Market offers jewelry, photography, pottery, clothing, paintings, woodworking, painted glass, and more from local artisans. Local restaurants on Harney Street offer an array of cuisines like locally roasted coffee, Mexican street food, and baked goods, showcasing the vibrance of Old Town.
